

Rule Golf with Golf Rules - MWMC Rules Quiz (2018-1)-ANS

Print your name CLEARLY on TOP of the page, circle your answer, and drop your entry into the Men's Club drawer slot. If preferred, e-mail your answers to the Rules Chairman. Each question is worth 1 point. The entry with the most points wins \$35 on the books at Maplewood G.C. For point's ties, a drawing will be held to determine the winner.

1. Your lie is just off the green. The flagstick was left tilted away from your line of play. A playing partner, competitor centers the flagstick in the hole prior to your play, without your consent. What's with that?
 - a. The playing partner, competitor takes two for possibly influencing your line of play.
 - b. Rub of the green, play on as it lies.
 - c. **You can have the flagstick returned to its original position. (Rule 17-4, Decision)**

2. A ball is visible in casual water but the player cannot retrieve it. Without it being known or virtually certain that it's their ball in the casual water, the player must treat their ball as lost outside the casual water.
 - a. **True (Rule 25-1/1, Decision)**
 - b. False

3. Your ball lies just off the putting green and casual water, on the green, intervenes between the ball and the hole. Your play is:
 - a. Relocate the balls position to a spot, no closer to the hole, free from the interference of the casual water.
 - b. Remove the casual water in your line of play.
 - c. **Play it as it lies. (Rules 25-1a/2, 13-2)**

4. Your tee shot comes to rest in a spot outside the closely mown area with no reasonable chance to make a stroke as it lies. What's your play?
 - a. No problem with MWMC Preferred Lies. Lift, clean & place within 6". Don't forget to mark the spot before you lift the ball.
 - b. Have to play it as an unplayable ball.
 - c. Just go big with a swing and see what happens.
 - d. **b or c. (MWMC Preferred Lies Rules)**

5. On the putting green you accidentally cause your ball to move:
 - a. Not good, take a stroke and play on.
 - b. Not good, take a stroke, replace the ball to its original position and play on.
 - c. **No problem, replace the ball to its original position and play on. (MWGC Local Rules)**
