Each question is worth 1 point. The entry with the most points wins \$35 on the books at Maplewood G.C. For point's ties, a drawing will be held to determine the winner.

In stroke play, a player deems his ball unplayable and lifts it. Then he discovers that the ball was in ground under repair. What is the ruling?

- A. If he drops a ball under the unplayable ball Rule, he may lift the ball and proceed under the ground under repair Rule without incurring any penalty strokes.
- B. If he drops a ball under the unplayable ball Rule back into the ground under repair, he may then lift the ball and proceed under the ground under repair Rule, incurring a total of two penalty strokes.
- C. If he does not drop a ball under the unplayable ball Rule, he may proceed under the ground under repair Rule without penalty.

If a dispute arises between players in match play and a member of the Committee is not readily available, they may discontinue play until a member of the Committee is available.

A player's caddie practices on the competition course before play on the day that the player's stroke-play competition is scheduled to begin. What is the ruling?

- A. There is no penalty.
- B. There is a two-stroke penalty.
- C. The caddie must be replaced.
- D. There is a disqualification penalty.

A player played a stroke from the putting green. The ball struck the hole-liner, which had stuck to the bottom of the flagstick and had come out of the hole when the person attending the flagstick removed it. Is there any penalty?

- A. There is no penalty.
- B. The stroke counts and there is two-stroke penalty.
- C. The ball is played as it lies, with a one-stroke penalty.

In match play, the players discontinue play after two holes due to severe weather. Later, they resume the match from the first hole. After the result is posted, the Committee becomes aware of the procedure. What is the ruling?

- A. The match must be resumed at the third hole and completed.
- B. The result of the match should stand as posted.
- C. They are disqualified.
