MWMC Rules Quiz (2022-2)

Print your name CLEARLY on TOP of the page, circle your answer, and drop your entry into the Men's Club drawer slot. If preferred, e-mail your answers to the Rules Chairman. Each question is worth 1 point. The entry with the most points wins \$50 on the books at Maplewood G.C. For points ties, a drawing will be held to determine the winner.

1. With ground under repair you get relief for:
 - a. Ball in G.U.R. only
 - b. **Ball and stance in G.U.R.** (Rule 16.1a)

2. Free relief from a cart path is:
 - a. One club length from the nearest edge of the path,
 - b. Two club lengths from the nearest edge of the path,
 - c. **Establish the nearest point of complete relief (reference point) from the path and one club length from there.** (Rule 16.1a,b)

3. On Maplewood's hole #7, between the orange marker poles, your ball crosses the cart path and comes to rest between the chain-link fence and the hanging net. It's considered OB.
 - a. True
 - b. **FALSE** MWGC Local Rules. OB is defined by the cyclone fence.

4. Your ball comes to rest in a penalty area. Your relief is:
 - a. Play it as it lies,
 - b. Play from the point of the original shot,
 - c. Take 2 club lengths relief from the point of entry,
 - d. With the point of entry lined up with the flagstick, go back as needed to establish your reference point for play.
 - e. **Any of the above.** (Rule 17)

5. For question #4, if you feel (d) is right, from your established reference point your relief is:
 - a. **One club length.** (Rule 17.1d(2))
 - b. Two club lengths.
