Finance (Dennis):

- Current Financial balance is \$31,928.84
- Current membership is 414 regular members and 119 associate members
- Payouts this month: tombstone \$9,530, 2-man shamble \$7,954.94, crystal \$1.932.28, engraving plaques \$272.32, bank fee \$6
- Income this month: tombstone \$8,593.28, 2-man shamble \$7,206.93, WA Golf \$3,363, dues \$1,390
- We have simplified the deposits and withdrawals with the automated banking on tournaments now which is helpful for tracking

Pro Shop / course (not present)

- Course is slow to recover from punch/sand in mid-March. Hoping that great improvements are made before spring field day. Tim to discuss with pro-shop on marking course out as lots of unplayable areas that are just dirt that would be good to mark as GUR.
- Kirk has finalized plan for home and home with Bellevue. Will be August 26th & 27th.
- Tournament committee to decide on if weather allows change to summer rules prior to Spring field day. This is the wish of all board members but is still weather dependent.

Tournaments (Terry)

• There are currently 135 signed up for Spring field day with a week to go. Number of players to be cut off at 180 due to daylight concerns.

- Had 120 players in 2-man shamble. Had one small issue with payouts, but for the most part no real issues and no time clock penalties.
- New info site is maplewoodmensclub.golfgenius.com. With this site should make it easier for all members to sign up for tournaments.
- Small issue with point tracking with the Tombstone tournament, but Terry is working to correct.

Handicap (James):

• Still struggling a little establishing new members, a handicap for tournaments when they don't have any or just a few scores.
