MWMC Rules Quiz (2023-2) ANS

Print your name CLEARLY on TOP of the page, circle your answer, and drop your entry into the Men's Club drawer slot. If preferred, e-mail your answers to the Rules Chairman. Each question is worth 1 point. The entry with the most points wins \$50 on the books at Maplewood G.C. For points ties, a drawing will be held to determine the winner.

1. On the course your ball at rest moves due to natural forces. It comes to rest still on the course. Your play is:
 - a. Replace the ball to its original position, No penalty.
 - b. Play it as it lies. No penalty. (Rule 9.3)
2. In the General Area your ball at rest, after being dropped, placed, or replaced, moves due to natural forces. It comes to rest in another area of the course. Your play is:
 - a. Replace the ball to its original position. No penalty. (Rule 9.3, Exp 2)
 - b. Play it as it is with applicable penalty for Bunker or Penalty areas.
3. On MWGC, Hole #7 you mistakenly tee off from outside of the markers. Your tee shot comes to rest OB. You're now playing your:
 - a. 3rd shot, (Rule 6.1b(2))
 - b. 4th shot,
 - c. 5th shot.
4. A player doesn't announce they're going to play a provisional ball until after their shot.
 - a. No big deal. They said, 'Provisional.'
 - b. Nope. That ball becomes their ball in play. (Rule 18.3b)
5. On the Putting Green, for free relief from an abnormal course condition (puddling water), relief must be taken on the Putting green.
 - a. True
 - b. False (Rule 16.1d)
6. Your tee shot lands in the fairway but has a chunk of mud on the club side of the ball. Your opponent asks you to mark and lift your ball. You replace the uncleaned ball back to its original position with the chunk of mud towards the hole.
 - a. Nice. Play on. (Rule 14.2c/1)
 - b. No way. The ball's not in the same position as when lifted.
