MWMC Rules Quiz (2023-1) ANSWERS

Print your name CLEARLY on TOP of the page, circle your answer, and drop your entry into the Men's Club drawer slot. If preferred, e-mail your answers to the Rules Chairman. Each question is worth 1 point. The entry with the most points wins \$50 on the books at Maplewood G.C. For points ties, a drawing will be held to determine the winner.

1. In match play, MW hole #6. Player A's ball comes to rest well short of the temp green. Player B's ball flies into the water just short of the bulkhead. Player B's next shot, from the drop area, goes into the hole. Player A tells him:
 - a. Great shot!
 - b. No good. You played out of turn. (Rule 6.4)

2. Back-on-the-line relief from a bunker is from where the ball entered the bunker or from it's at rest position.
 - a. Point of entry into the bunker.
 - b. Point of rest in the bunker. (Rule 16.1)

3. Back-on-the-line relief from a Penalty Area is from where the ball entered the PA or the closest point to where the ball came to rest in the PA.
 - a. The closest point to the edge of the PA.
 - b. From the point of entry into the PA. (Rule 17)

4. Taking back-on-the-line-relief. The ball when dropped must come to rest:
 - a. Within one club length of the point the ground is 1st contacted, no closer to the hole.
 - b. Within one club length of the point the ground is 1st contacted, in any direction. (Rule 16.1, 17.1)

5. Relief for an embedded ball can be taken:
 - a. Anywhere on the course.
 - b. Only in the General Area. (Rule 16.3)
 - c. In Penalty Areas and Bunkers also.
