1. Your shot ends up plugged, embedded in the General Area but in the rough. You only get to place the ball within 6" of its position.
  - a. True
  - b. False (Rule 16.3 )
2. All balls that come to rest on the green must be marked and lifted.
  - a. Yes
  - b. No
  - c. Maybe (Rule 15.3)
3. Back-on-the-Line relief procedure allows a one club-length area of play from which the ball must come to rest. The ball must be dropped,
  - a. Within that one club-length area of relief,
  - b. On the line of relief. (Rule 14.3b(3))
4. Your tee shot on #18, at Maplewood, clears the pond but is in the Penalty Area. The standing irrigation pipes are in your line of play. Do you get free relief for the immovable obstruction?

  - b. No (Rule 17.3)

5. Back-on-the-line relief from a bunker is from the point where the ball entered the bunker or from it's at rest position.
